

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners will conduct a public hearing on proposed amendments to the FY2018 Budget as required by Sections 129.06(2)(f) and 129.06(3)(b), Florida Statutes, relating to the increase of transfers and realignment of reserves as specified herein.

A public hearing on amending the budget will be held on **Tuesday, September 25, 2018 at 6:00 p.m.** in the County Commission Assembly Room, Fifth Floor, Pinellas County Courthouse, 315 Court Street, Clearwater, Florida 33756. The proposed amendments are as follows:
