Description & Comments

This is for the approval of the application and resolution certifying that monies received from the State Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Trust Fund will be used to improve and expand pre-hospital emergency medical services. The State of Florida dispenses funds annually after the end of the state's fiscal year for the prior year from the EMS Trust Fund to Boards of County Commissioners upon their application to the State. These funds cannot supplant existing County EMS budget allocations.

The grant rules require the Board of County Commissioners to submit a Resolution each year specifying the grant funds will be used to improve and expand the County pre-hospital EMS systems. The award will be for \$140,321.03 and will be used for a Pilot Program for Consultant for a 9-1-1 Opioid Overdose Response Addiction Specialist; EMS Professional Education Support; EMS Public Outreach; and a Rehabilitation Unit vehicle to support EMS Rehabilitation Operations.

The \$140,321.03 revenues and offset expenditures are consistent and included in the FY24 Adopted budget within the EMS fund. No matching funds are associated with this grant.
