We have completed a preliminary review of our PM 2.5 Grant award and have noticed the award does not reflect the updated Indirect Rate of 44.12% requested December 16, 2020 for the second project year. Will this require an amendment to the award if we are not requesting the dollars in any object class categories to change? In the past, where adjustments to the allowable percent Indirect Rates were requested without change dollar amounts, Award Headquarters has been able to change just the percent on the current award and re-send the corrected document back to our agency.

We do anticipate three staff members associated with this project receiving position upgrades during the FY22 efforts (Chemist 2 upgraded to Chemist 3, Environmental Specialist 2 upgraded to Environmental Specialist 3, Environmental Specialist 1 upgraded to Environmental Specialist 2). However, we believe the current TOTAL Object Class dollar estimates we included in our applications for Personnel, Indirects and Fringe expenses over the past two project periods will not exceed the current Total dollar amounts reflected in the awards. Our request is for the allowable percent Indirect Rates to be corrected.

Please let me know if there is any assistance we can provide. I have attached the support documents to reflect the 44.12 % Indirect Rate requested. I have high-lighted the applicable area of the *Budget Summary Page* on Page 3 of the award.

Please advise if we will be receiving an updated document to include in our County's Administrative process for approval.
