Description & Comments

This is the first amendment to an agreement between the County and LogistiCare Solutions, LLC that enables the County to receive reimbursement for non-emergency ambulance transport for Medicaid recipients. The agreement will continue to have a term of one (1) year and will continue to automatically renew each year, for an additional one (1) year timeframe, until either party decides to terminate the agreement.

The amendment to the agreement will allow the County to receive an increased reimbursement rate for non-emergency ambulance transport for Medicaid recipients. The previous reimbursement rates of \$136.00 for Basic Life Support (BLS) transports, and \$190.00 for Advanced Life Support (ALS) transports, have now been increased to \$226.63 and \$271.95 respectively. Based on estimated transport volumes, this increased reimbursement rate will equate to an additional \$200,000 in revenue to the Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Fund, bringing the the total reimbursement for these services to approximately \$514,000. The annual cost to the County for non-emergency transports for Medicaid recipients is approximately \$900,000.

The estimated revenue of \$514,000 is consistent with revenues included in the FY20 Proposed Budget for the EMS fund.
