

## FIRST AMENDMENT

This Amendment is made and entered into on the date last executed below ("Effective Date"), by and between Pinellas County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "County," and Polydyne Inc., Riceboro, GA hereinafter referred to as "Contractor," (individually referred to as "Party", collectively "Parties").

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and the Contractor entered into an agreement on July 13, 2021, referred to as Pinellas County Contract No. 21-0219-B-BW (hereinafter "Agreement"), pursuant to which the Contractor agreed to provide Methanol and Glycerin 70%; and

WHEREAS, Section 21 ("Amendment") of the Agreement permits modification by mutual written agreement of the parties; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Contractor now wish to modify the Agreement in order to provide for a term extension, and an increase to the contract value at the same terms and conditions;

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree that the Agreement is amended as follows:

1. The Parties agree to extend the term of the Agreement an additional twenty-four months from July 12, 2026, to July 12, 2028, in accordance with section 4 ("Term of Agreement"), subsection B ("Term Extension").
2. The total not to exceed contract sum of \$3,125,250.00, as stated in Section 5 ("Compensation and Method of Payment"), subsection B, is revised to reflect an increase in the amount of \$1,200,000.00, for a new total not to exceed sum of \$4,325,250.00. In no event will the annual expenditure exceed \$617,892.86 in any given fiscal year without a written amendment to the Agreement.
3. Except as changed or modified herein, all provisions and conditions of the original Agreement and any amendments thereto shall remain in full force and effect.

Each Party to this Amendment represents and warrants that: (i) it has the full right and authority and has obtained all necessary approvals to enter into this Amendment; (ii) each person executing this Amendment on behalf of the Party is authorized to do so; (iii) this Amendment constitutes a valid and legally binding obligation of the Party, enforceable in accordance with its terms.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the Parties herein have caused this First Amendment to be executed by their undersigned officials, who are duly authorized to bind the Parties to the Amendment.


