This OMB Grants Team has conducted a review of the Human Services intent to apply for the FY25 DNA CEBR Formula Grant Program funded by Bureau of Justice Assistance.

Project Scope of Work

Funding will be used to aid in performing DNA analysis for the purposes of capacity enhancement and backlog reduction by funding the following positions/equipment: (1) The salaries and benefits of one full-time and one part-time DNA Analyst to perform casework and technical reviews of casework submitted to the forensic lab by local law enforcement; (2) Fund DNA kits (extraction, quantitation, and amplification) for use by grant funded analysts in casework submitted to the laboratory from the local criminal justice community.
