Date/Time/Comments: The purpose of this JFA is to continue to provide funding in the joint effort with the USGS to collect scientific data. This data is used to develop watershed management plans, design surface water management projects, and comply with the County's National Pollution Discharge Elimination System storm water permit. This agreement covers the period from May 1, 2016 to April 30, 2017.

NOTES: The USGS has constructed and installed data gathering stations at various locations throughout the County. The stations allow continuous monitoring of flood stage, discharge, and rainfall data. This information, combined with water quality samples taken by County staff at various stations about every six weeks using U.S. Environmental Protection Agency guidelines, will allow us to better react to and meet existing and emerging federal and state water quality requirements. It will also allow for the planning and designing of systems to address flood management throughout the County. The Water Discipline Data Collection Program has been an ongoing program since 1999.
