Review & Comments

The OMB Grants Team has conducted a review of the **Public Works** intent to apply for the **Surveys, Studies, Research, Investigations, Demonstrations, and Special Purpose Activities Relating to the Clean Air Act** funded by **U.S. Environmental Agency (EPA)**.

Project Scope of Work

This grant program/project has been ongoing since 1998. The program monitors fine particulate matter air pollution levels in accordance with EPA requirements and standards to demonstrate compliance with National Ambient Air Quality Standards. This application is for an additional two-year budget/project period award to support continued funding of the existing County program.

Benefit Summary

This project supports Pinellas County's Strategic Plan Goal 3.3 (Practice Superior Environmental Stewardship) to protect and improve the quality of our air. This project supports EPA's Strategic Plan Goal 1 (A Cleaner, Healthier Environment) and Objective 1.1 (Improve Air Quality), by implementing a variety of monitoring activities that will assist in achieving and maintaining health-based air pollution standards to reduce the direct emission of particulate matter and other criteria air pollution from stationary and mobile sources that are protective of human health. The anticipated environmental outcome will be reduced respiratory illnesses including asthma and lung cancer and improved visibility in scenic parks and wilderness areas.

Anticipated Impact to the County Budget

This is a **Multi Year** grant affecting **FY25, FY26 & FY27**. This Application request is for \$189,158.00 with no match required. The total project budget is \$189,158.00.
