To address the County Commission in person, members of the public are encouraged to preregister at pinellas.gov/comment. Preregistration is encouraged but not required if individuals plan to attend the meeting. Those who have not preregistered may register when they arrive

Members of the public wishing to address the body virtually via Zoom or by phone are required to preregister by 5:00 P.M. the day before the meeting by visiting <u>pinellas.gov/comment</u>. The registration form requires full name, address and telephone number if joining by phone, along with the topic or agenda item to be addressed. If a member of the public does not log in with the same Zoom name or phone number provided in the registration form, they may not be recognized to speak,

The current Office category is used to depict areas that are developed, or appropriate to be developed, with office uses, low impact employment uses, and residential uses (subject to an acreage threshold), in areas characterized by a transition between residential and commercial uses and in areas well-suited for community-scale residential/office mixed use development. The current and proposed Employment category is used to depict areas that are developed with, or appropriate to be developed with, a wide range of employment uses. including primary industries (i.e., those with a customer base that extends beyond Pinellas County), allowing for flex space, and for uses that have minimal

The current and proposed Target Employment Center category is an overlay used to depict those areas of the county that are now developed, or appropriate to be developed, in a concentrated and cohesive pattern to facilitate employment uses of countywide significance.



Location: Generally located at the 22nd Street South SunRunner bus station, south of 1st Avenue South, east of 24th Street South and north and west of Interstate 275



The current and proposed Industrial category is used to depict areas developed, or appropriate to be developed, in a general industrial manner, and so as to encourage the reservation and use of areas for industrial use in a manner consistent with surrounding use, transportation facilities, other necessary infrastructure, and natural resources.

The current and proposed Activity Center category is used to recognize those areas of the county that have been identified and planned for in a special and detailed manner, serve as identifiable centers of business, public, and residential activity that are the focal point of a community, and are served by enhanced transit commensurate with the type. Scale, and intensity of use.

The current and proposed Target Employment Center (TEC) category is an overlay used to depict those areas of the county that are now developed. or appropriate to be developed, in a concentrated and cohesive pattern to facilitate employment uses of countywide significance

Pursuant to Section 6.5.4.4.1-2 of the Countywide Rules, the City is adopting a special area plan (SAP) to implement the TEC-Local subcategory, which allows greater flexibility within TECs that have warehouse and industrial footprints but do not fit within traditional target industry categories. The SAP may govern allowable uses, density and intensity standards, and other relevant land use regulations and development requirements in accordance with specified guidelines.

In review of the ordinance(s) above, there may be modifications that arise at the public hearing and/or with other responsible parties

Forward Pinellas has made an advisory recommendation to the CPA for each proposed amendment. The subsequent action of the CPA may amend the Countywide Plan Map from the existing plan category to another plan category as may be determined appropriate based on the public hearings and consistent with the Countywide Plan and procedures related

Persons are advised that if they decide to appeal any decision made at the meeting/hearing, they will need a record of the proceedings, and, for such purposes, they may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
