



- TS Wind Most Likely Timing
 - Arrival: Thursday (09/26) 8:00 AM
 - Departure: Thursday (09/26) 7:00 PM
- Wind Speed Probabilities
 - 81% Tropical Storm
 - 44% Strong Tropical Storm
- Isolated Tornadoes Possible
- Flooding heavy rains of up to 10" possible
- Storm Surge Flooding likely to last
 24 36 Hours
