Review Comments:	Project cost is high vs. total impact/households served. Of the \$473,911 requested, \$269,911 is operational costs and \$204,000 for client needs including \$104,000 for non-congregate shelter assistance for 12 households, \$50,000 for homelessness prevention assistance for 10 households and \$50,000 for rapid re-housing for 9 households.
