### Review & Comments

The OMB Grants Team has conducted a review of the **Airport's** intent to apply for the **Airport Infrastructure Grant (AIG)** funded by the **Federal Aviation Administration (FAA)**.

#### Project Scope of Work

This grant will pay for Construction Administration Services related to the Terminal Expansion project.

#### Benefit Summary

PIE has experienced 142% growth in 11 years, and the current terminal facility is having issues meeting that growth. We need more passenger seating, more concession space, more security lines, and expansion of gates. This project is very important in keeping our passenger experience positive and in line with possible air carrier growth.

#### Anticipated Impact to the County Budget

This is a **single-year** grant potentially affecting **FY26**. This application request is for \$647,143.00 with a \$71,905.00 cost share requirement. The total project budget is \$719,048.00.

#### Grant Review Comments

- If grant funding is awarded, the fiscal impact will be in FY26, and an analysis of the total project budget will be made at that time.
- The grant application will require County Administrator approval for submission.
