HUMAN SERVICES SUBRECIPIENT FUNDING AGREEMENT FIRST AMENDMENT

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT, is effective upon the date entered below, by and between PINELLAS COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "County", and the PINELLAS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, hereinafter referred to as "Agency." The Parties hereby amend the Human Services Subrecipient Funding Agreement between the County and Agency dated February 5, 2019, as follows:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on February 5th, 2019, the County and Agency did enter into a Subrecipient Funding Agreement to facilitate the administration of grant activities (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the County has received Approval of a Project Period Extension Grant Agreement Modification, from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women (OVW), to extend the project end date of the Grant for twelve (12) months, until September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the County, as the recipient of the award extension, finds it necessary to amend the subrecipient funding agreement with Agency to provide for the additional twelve months of grant activities, expenditures, financial accounting, and reporting, in accordance with grant requirements; and

WHEREAS, Agency has provided and continues to provide services consistent with the requirements of the federal grant funds in an efficient manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, it is agreed by and between the County and Agency to amend the Agreement as follows:

- 1. The above "WHEREAS" clauses are incorporated into and made a part of this Agreement.
- 2. Section 1(x), Specific Grant Information, is amended to change Contact Information for Awarding Official of the Pass-Through Entity to Karen Yatchum, Pinellas County Human Services. All other information of the paragraph 1(x) shall remain the same.
 - Section 3, Term of Agreement, is hereby amended to add the following:
 The term of the Agreement is hereby extended for one year, through September 30, 2022.
