JULY 4, 1776 – JULY 4, 2026**

- WHEREAS,** on July 4, 1776, the Declaration of Independence was adopted, establishing the United States of America and affirming the principles of liberty, equality, and self-government; and
- WHEREAS,** the year 2026 marks the 250th Anniversary of the founding of the United States of America, a historic milestone known as the Semiquincentennial; and
- WHEREAS,** for two and a half centuries, the United States has stood as a symbol of freedom, democracy, and opportunity, shaped by the courage, innovation, and dedication of its people; and
- WHEREAS,** this anniversary provides an opportunity for all Americans to reflect on the nation’s history, honor the contributions of those who came before us, and inspire future generations to continue the work of building a more perfect union; and
