**Description & Comments**

(What is it, any issues found, is there a financial impact to current/next FY, does this contract vary from previous FY, etc.)

This agreement between the County and LogistiCare Solutions, LLC, will serve as a mechanism for the County to receive reimbursement for non-emergency ambulance transport for Medicaid recipients. This agreement has a term of one (1) year from the effective date. The agreement automatically renews each year, for an additional one (1) year timeframe, until either party decides to terminate the agreement.

Under this agreement, the County will be able to receive reimbursement, which is estimated at \$300,000 in FY19, for these services. The County has been unable to collect payments for these services since June of 2014 due to Medicaid’s Managed Medical Assistance Program (MMA) going into effect, and having the requirement that medical service providers contract with various MMA plans to receive reimbursement. The annual cost to the County for non-emergency transports for Medicaid recipients is approximately \$900,000.

The estimated revenue of \$300,000 is included in the FY19 Proposed Budget for the EMS fund.
