#### Review & Comments

This is an intent to apply for the **Beach Management Funding Assistance Program** program grant through the **Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP)**.

#### Project Scope of Work

The Pass-a-Grille Beach nourishment is currently set to begin construction in July once the final permit modification is received. The contractor will dredge about 140,000 cy of sand from Pass-a-Grille channel and place it on Pass-a-Grille Beach. This grant will cover these costs as well as during and post construction monitoring costs.

#### Benefit Summary

The beach that will be built will have many benefits including recreational, storm damage protection, and habitat restoration. It also fulfills several key points of the strategic plan below. This grant will help offset the county's costs.
