




# FY 20/21 Medical Examiner Workload


- District autopsies up 9.98%

- Pasco autopsies up 10.33%







# Pinellas Autopsies and Scenes FY18-FY21







# Pasco Autopsies and Scenes FY18-FY21






# DRUG RELATED ACCIDENTAL DEATHS 2009-2021






# PINELLAS OPIOID/OPIATE ACCIDENTAL DEATHS

# Outlook and Strategies

- Unprecedented workload increase due to synthetic opioids
- Pasco workload would justify a satellite office
  - Pasco County workload greatly increased by synthetic opioids
