The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners, in its capacity as the Countywide Planning Authority (CPA), will conduct a public hearing on proposed amendments to the Countywide Plan Map, pursuant to the Countywide Plan, as amended, and as set forth in the listing below.

A public hearing on the ordinances with virtual public participation and an on-site participation option will be held on Tuesday. December 7. 2021, at 6:00 P.M., or as soon thereafter as may be accommodated by the completion of the rest of the Board agenda, in the Magnolia Room at Pinellas County Extension (Florida Botanical Gardens), 12520 Ulmerton Road, Largo, Florida 33774, with virtual participation munications Media Technology (CMT) on the Zoom platform.

Interested parties may appear at the hearing or use one of the other methods below to be heard regarding the proposed ordinances to be considered by the County Commission in its role as the CPA.

Members of the public wishing to address the body may attend in person, attend virtually or provide comments in advance. Space for in-person attendance is very limited due to COVID-19 social distancing. Members of the public are strongly encouraged to participate virtually or to provide comments in advance.

Activity Center Activity Center

Northwest corner of Gandy Boulevard and I-275

The current and proposed Activity Center category is intended to recognize those areas of the county that have been identified and planned for in a special and detailed manner, based on their unique location, intended use, appropriate density/intensity, and pertinent planning considerations. In particular, it is the intent of this category to recognize those important, identifiable centers of business, public, and residential activity, as may be appropriate to the particular circumstance, that are the focal point of a community, and served by enhanced transit commensurate with the type, scale, and intensity of use. Activity Centers are designed at a size and scale that allows for internal circulation by pedestrians, bicyclists, and transit users, and typically encompass areas developed in a radial pattern within walking distance (4 to 1/2 mile) of a central point or hub served by transit.

While the Countywide Plan Map category is remaining the same as Activity Center, the City's underlying local future land use category is proposed to be amended from Industrial Limited to Planned Redevelopment – Commercial, to accommodate a maximum of 500 units for multifamily residential housing in addition to a maximum 1,000,000 square foot (sf) industrial project. Residential is not permitted under the City's Industrial Limited future land use category. Since the local amendment proposes to convert industrial land to a non-industrial use, it is subject to the Countywide Plan Map

Retail & Services, Employment, and Target Employment Center

Location:

Retail & Services and Target Employment Center Approximately 750 ft. southwest of Ulmerton Rd. & 49th St. N.

The current Employment category is used to depict areas that are developed with, or appropriate to be developed with, a wide range of employment uses, including primary industries (i.e., those with a customer base that extends beyond Pinellas County), allowing for flex space, and for uses that have minimal external impacts. The current and proposed Retail & Services category is used to depict areas developed with a mix of businesses that provide for the shopping and personal service needs of the community or region, provide for employment opportunities and accommodate target employment uses, and may include residential uses as part of the mix of uses. The current and proposed Target Employment Center category is an overlay used to depict those areas of the county that are now developed, or appropriate to be developed, in a concentrated and cohesive pattern to facilitate employment uses of countywide significance.

In review of the ordinances above, there may be modifications that arise at the public hearing and/or with other responsible parties.

Forward Pinellab Ass made an advisory recommendation to the CPA for each proposed amendment. The subsequent action of the CPA may amend the Countywide Plan Map from the existing plan category to another plan category as may be determined appropriate based on the public hearings and consistent with the Countywide Plan and procedures related thereto

Persons are advised that if they decide to appeal any decision made at the meeting/hearing, they will need a record of the proceedings, and, for such purposes, they may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
