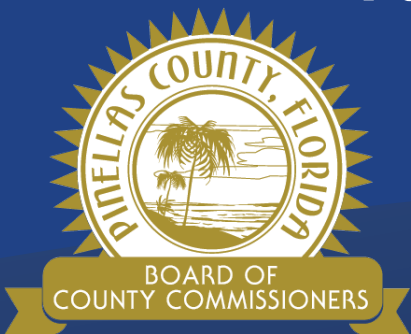

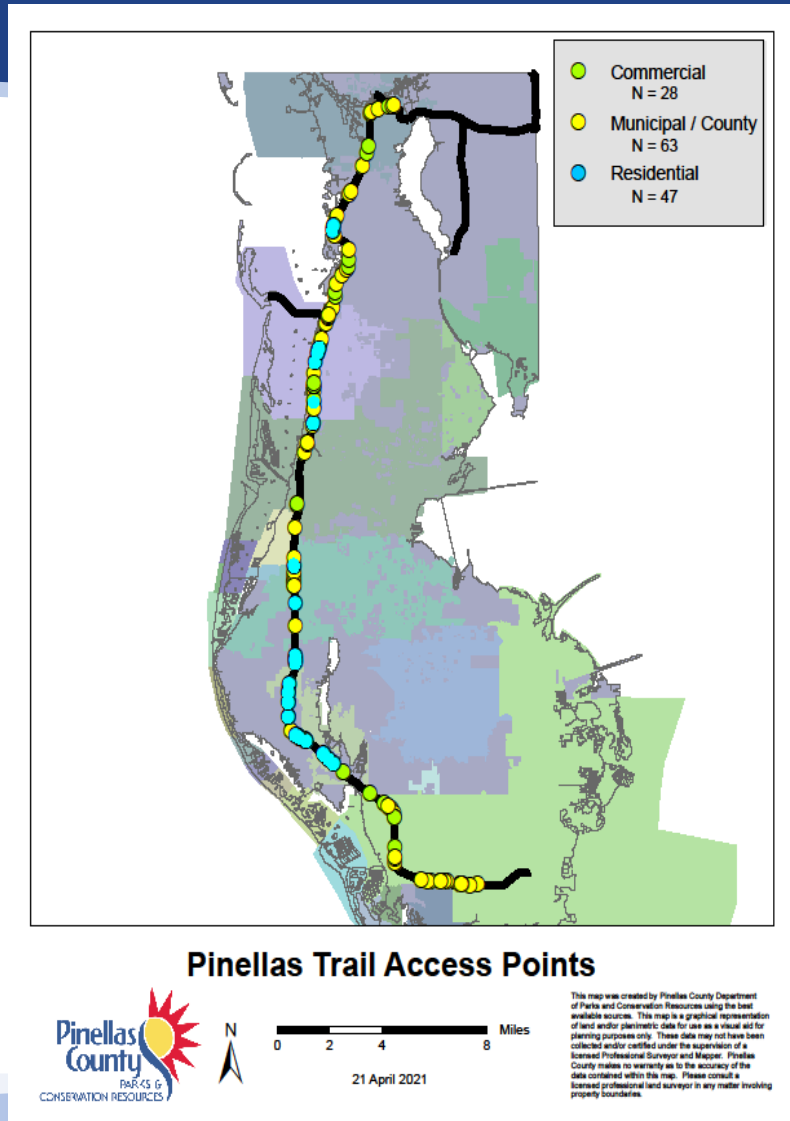

Direction Received

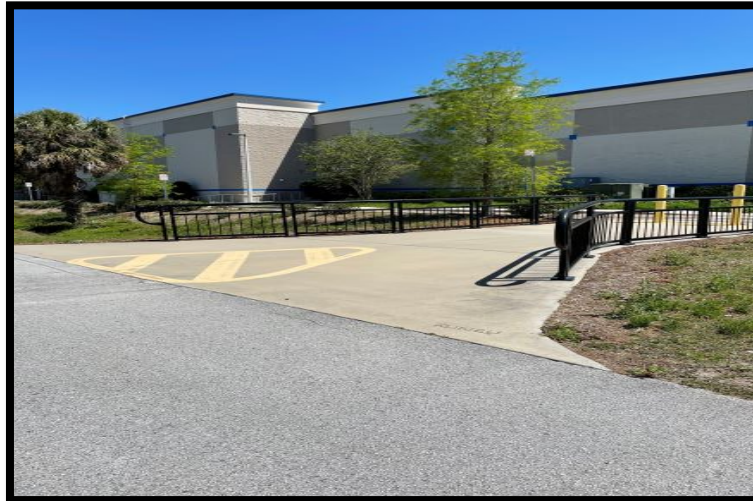
- Board interested in greater consideration for commercial connections

Formation of a Process

Public Purpose

- No conflict with the FLDOT transfer agreement

Support and Involvement from the Cities

- Letter of intent was sent to all six municipalities

Identification of stakeholders in the County

- Formation of a working group representing Public Works, Parks, Building Development & Review Services, Administrative Services, County Attorney, and Forward Pinellas
- Intended to look like the Contract Review system

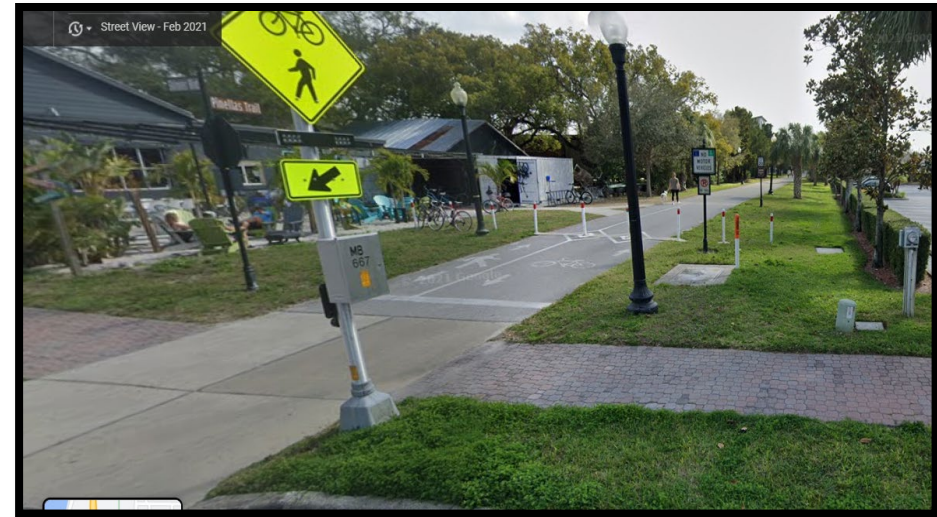
