**Qualification Requirements:** Reviews and makes recommendations on rates, formation, implementation and revisions of policies and programs for solid waste disposal and establishment and location of waste disposal and resource recovery facilities.

The Committee consists of 13 members, as follows: two members shall be appointed by the BCC; two members shall be appointed by the city commissions for Clearwater, Dunedin, Largo, Pinellas Park, St. Petersburg Beach and Tarpon Springs. Each of the above members shall serve at the pleasure of the appointing body. One member shall be appointed by the combined city commissions of Belleair, Belleair Bluffs, Oldsmar and Safety Harbor. One member shall be appointed by the combined city commissions of Seminole, Kenneth City, Gulfport and South Pasadena. One member shall be appointed by the combined city commissions of Indian Rocks Beach, Indian Shores, Belleair Beach, Belleair Shores, North Redington Beach, Redington Beach, Redington Shores, Treasure Island and Madeira Beach. Each member serving for a combined municipality shall hold office for two years.

Of the two BCC appointments, one has been a Department of Solid Waste staff member and the second a representative of the private hauler stakeholder community.

Per the County Code, each appointed member of the committee shall be a qualified professional person having experience in the field of solid waste collection and disposal, utility management, health, public administration, engineering, accounting, economics, auditing, or environmental resources.
