## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING PROPOSED RESOLUTION REVISING THE FEE FOR DISPOSAL OF APPROVED SOLID WASTE

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners proposes to increase the fee for disposal of approved solid waste by Resolution.

A public hearing on the Resolution will be held on Tuesday, June 21, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. in the County Commission Assembly Room, Fifth Floor, Pinellas County Courthouse, 315 Court Street, Clearwater, Florida 33756.

THE PROPOSED RESOLUTION INCREASES THE FEE FOR APPROVED SOLID WASTE FROM THE CURRENT RATE OF \$44.70 PER TON TO:

- \$47.75 per ton effective October 1, 2022.
  - \$51.00 per ton effective October 1, 2023.
- \$54.50 per ton effective October 1, 2024.
