A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF THE WEST 0.13-ACRE PORTION OF A 0.37-ACRE PARCEL LOCATED AT 3205 US ALTERNATE 19 N IN CRYSTAL BEACH; PAGE 69 OF THE ZONING ATLAS, AS BEING IN SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 27, RANGE 15; FROM R-4, ONE, TWO & THREE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL TO C-2, GENERAL COMMERCIAL & SERVICES; UPON APPLICATION OF SIX EXPANDED ENTERPRISES, LLC THROUGH HOUSH GHOVAEE, CEO, NORTHSIDE ENGINEERING, INC., ZON-22-02
