PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE PINELLAS COUNTY FUTURE LAND USE MAP AND ZONING ATLAS

The Pinellas County Board of County Commissioners proposes to adopt the following Ordinance and Resolutions amending the Pinellas County Future Land Use Map and Zoning Atlas.

A public hearing on the Ordinance and Resolutions with virtual public participation and an on-site participation option, to be held on **Tuesday, August 16, 2022, at 6:00 P.M.** or thereafter in the County Commission Assembly Room, Fifth Floor, Pinellas County Courthouse, 315 Court Street, Clearwater, Florida 33756, with virtual participation utilizing Communications Media Technology (CMT) on the Zoom platform.

The public hearing will be streamed live at https://youtube.com/pcctv1 and www.pinellascounty.org/TV, and broadcast on the Pinellas County cable public access channels:

Members of the public wishing to address the body may attend in person, attend virtually or provide comments in advance.

To address the County Commission in person, members of the public are encouraged to preregister at <u>pinellascounty.org/comment</u>. Preregistration is encouraged but not required if individuals plan to attend the meeting at the Assembly Room. Those who have not preregistered may register when they arrive.

Members of the public wishing to address the body virtually via Zoom or by phone are required to preregister by 5:00 P.M. the day before the meeting by visiting <u>pinellascounty.org/comment</u>. All comments on any agenda item received by 5:00 P.M. the day before the meeting will be included as part of the official record for this meeting and will be available to be considered by the County Commission prior to any action taken.

1. ZON-22-03

A Resolution changing the Zoning classification of approximately 0.31 acre located at 8226 46th Avenue North in west Lealman; Page 300 of the Zoning Atlas, as being in Section 01, Township 31, Range 15; from R-4, One, Two & Three Family Residential to GO, General Office; upon application of Mathew T. & Christine Peeters. (Quasi-Judicial)

2. FLU-22-03

An Ordinance amending the Future Land Use Map of Pinellas County, Florida by changing the Land Use designation of approximately 13.1 acres located at 10055 Seminole Boulevard in unincorporated Seminole located in Section 22, Township 30, Range 15; from Residentia/Office General (5.5 acres) & Preservation (7.6 acres) to Employment (5.5 acres) & Preservation (7.6 acres); upon application of Superior Uniform Group, Inc. through Robert Pergolizzi, AICP, PTP, Gulf Coast Consulting, Inc., Representative, and providing an effective date.

A Resolution changing the Zoning classification of approximately 13.1 acres located at 10055 Seminole Boulevard in unincorporated Seminole; Page 267 of the Zoning Atlas, as being in Section 22, Township 30, Range 15; from GO, General Office (13.1 acres) to E-1, Employment-1 (5.5 acres) and PC, Preservation/ Conservation (7.6 acres); upon application of Superior Uniform Group, Inc. through Robert Pergolizzi, AICP, PTP, Gulf Coast Consulting, Inc., Representative, (Quasi-Judicial)

4. ZON-22-06 (First Hearing)

A Resolution changing the Zoning classification of approximately 12 acres located on the south side of Duval Park Boulevard approximately 400 feet east of 44th Way North in Lealman; Page 793 of the Zoning Atlas, as being in Section 0.3 Township 31. Range 16; from RPD, Residential Planned Development (4.14 acres) & PC, Preservation/Conservation (7.86 acres) to FBR, Facility-Based Recreation (12 acres); upon application of Pinellas County Government through Pinellas County Public Works, Rhonda Bowrnan, Representative. (Quasi-Judicial)
