



Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners is hereby giving notice of a regularly scheduled public meeting, with virtual public participation utilizing Communications Media Technology, to be held on **Thursday, September 22nd, 2022, at 12:00 PM** in the Palm Room, Pinellas County Communications Building, 10000 US Highway 19 North, Clearwater, Florida 34622.

The hearing is to consider the petition of Pinellas County for the vacating of a portion of a 30.00-foot Right-of-Way lying on the plat of TAMPA AND TARPON STREET, Plat Book 1, Page 116 of the public records of Pinellas County, which Pinellas County was formerly a part of, Township 27 South, Range 16 East, Pinellas County, Florida.
