## RESOLUTION NO. 22- 78

## SUPPLEMENTING FY22 BUDGET

WHEREAS, Section 129.06(2)(d), F.S., provides that receipts of a nature from a source not anticipated in the FY22 Budget, and received for a particular purpose may, by Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, be appropriated and expended for that purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, unanticipated revenues are to be received and these funds are to be appropriated and expended for the purpose for which received.

**WHEREAS**, Section 129.06(2)(b), F.S., provides that appropriations from the reserve for contingencies may be made to increase the appropriation for any particular expense in the same fund, or to create an appropriation in the fund for any lawful purpose, but expenditures may not be charged directly to the reserve for contingencies.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida, in a public meeting duly assembled this 22nd day of September, 2022, that receipts from a source not anticipated and received for a particular purpose are to be appropriated and added to the General Fund budget, within General Government, and the total County budget for FY22 as follows:
