RESOLUTION ADOPTING FINAL MILLAGE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 PINELLAS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT FUND

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners as taxing authority for the Pinellas County Health Department Fund, in public hearing duly assembled this 22nd day of September, 2022, that the Board of County Commissioners hereby adopts the final millage rate for the Pinellas County Health Department Fund as established pursuant to said hearing for the fiscal year 2022-2023 as **0.0790** mills, which millage rate represents a **12.06%** increase in property taxes for the said fiscal year over the rolled-back rate of **0.0705**.
