RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 115

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN PINELLAS COUNTY AND THE CITY OF TAMPA FOR LIMITED SOLID WASTE PROCESSING SERVICES; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Tampa ("City") and Pinellas County desire mutual assistance for solid waste processing; and

WHEREAS, Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, encourages municipalities to utilize interlocal agreements as a means to "make the most efficient use of their powers"; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is the best interest of the citizens of the City to enter into an Interlocal Agreement to provide mutual assistance for solid waste processing.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TAMPA, FLORIDA, THAT:

- Section 1. That the Interlocal Agreement Between Pinellas County and City of Tampa for Limited Solid Waste Services ("Agreement") is approved, attached hereto, and incorporated herein in the same or substantially similar form.
- Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of Tampa is authorized to execute and the City Clerk/Deputy City Clerk to attest and affix the Official Seal of the City of Tampa to said Agreement on behalf of the City.
- Section 3. That the proper officers of the City of Tampa are hereby authorized and empowered to do all things necessary and proper to carry out and make effective the terms and conditions of this Resolution and attached Agreement
- Section 4. This resolution approves an Agreement between the City and Pinellas County for mutual assistance for solid waste processing services on an as-needed basis. Both parties agree to pay the current established tipping fees and agree to waive any out-of-county or out-of-city surcharge fees. Payments to Pinellas County shall be remitted from the Solid Waste Operations Fund and shall be controlled by requisition, subject to annual appropriation. Revenue received from Pinellas County shall be deposited into the Solid Waste Operations Fund.
- Section 5. That the City Clerk shall file a fully executed copy of the Agreement in the official records of the City of Tampa as maintained by the Office of the City Clerk.
 - Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
