This item is the recommendation for Elite Events funding from the Tourist Development Council (TDC), not the County. The TDC is recommending funding 34 events in the FY24 Elite Events programs for a total of \$2,045,000, exceeding the number of events and amount of funding recommended by the CVB. The FY24 Proposed Budget to the BCC includes \$2.0M of funding for Elite Events, which is the maximum amount allowed under the current Pinellas County Tourist Development Plan.

The CVB reviewed and scored all eligible applications, 39 in total, and found 33 met the minimum score and recommended funding those events for a total of \$1,820,000.

The staff report should be edited to reflect the recommendation of the CVB staff, who followed the established guidelines to review and score the applications to come up with their recommendations.

If the approved agreements exceed the budgeted amount (\$2.0M), lapse should be utilized to cover the difference, not a budget amendment.
