Description & Comments

A budget amendment by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners through public hearing to recognize unanticipated revenue, unanticipated fund balance, and realign funds.

With ARPA obligation deadlines approaching, OMB and County Administration, along with the respective Departments are proposing to realign funds from projects that will not meet the December 31, 2024, deadline, to projects that are more likely to meet the deadline, or are already obligated. The resolution realigns a total of \$6,929,000 in FY24, and the FY25 budget cycle will realign an additional \$7,500,000.

An unanticipated fund balance has been calculated in the General Fund in the amount of \$33,873,000. This resolution will recognize that fund balance, then transfer \$31,123,000 to the Capital Projects Fund and \$2,750,000 to the Surface Water Utility Fund. Those funds will then be appropriated to multiple capital projects and operating expenditure accounts within the respective funds.

An additional \$4,953,000 is needed to fund the interlocal agreement with City of Madeira Beach for Redington Rescue Station 002996A (Granicus item 24-0253A in the amount of \$7,400,000). The needed funding will be appropriated from Capital Projects Future Year Reserves 001247A.
