
CONSTRUCTION LICENSING BOARD



The Construction Licensing Board is funded by revenues from licensing fees, administrative fines and citations that are apart from the County and does not receive any property tax support. For FY17, revenues are estimated as follows: \$712,500 for the construction licensing fees, \$285,000 for citations, \$190,000 for fines and \$3,720 in interest and miscellaneous revenues. FY17 expenditures are increasing by \$146,660, or 10.9%, related to inflation and increased cost allocation charges. Revenues and accumulated reserves will fully support this increase.

CONSTRUCTION LICENSING BOARD

 The Construction Licensing Board regulates the construction and home improvement industry through uniform contractor competency licensing, code adoption and code interpretations. There are twenty-one members on the Construction Licensing Board. The Building Directors of Pinellas County and the cities of Clearwater and St. Petersburg are permanent members. The remaining eighteen members are appointed by the Board of County Commissioners to serve two-year terms.
