

FY17 Budget Request by Expenditure Type




Forward Pinellas is the new brand for the unified agency that was formed by the Pinellas County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) merging with the Pinellas Planning Council (PPC). The PPC is a dependent special district that acts as the advisory body to the Countywide Planning Authority. Chapter 88-464, Laws of Florida, states that the Board of County Commissioners has the right to review and adjust the PPC's approved budget and certify its millage. The maximum millage rate that can be levied is 0.1666 mills. The PPC is proposing a reduction in its millage rate from 0.0160 to 0.0150 in FY17. The PPC is reimbursed by the MPO for staff services and shared operating expenses. The PPC is not included in the County's budget; and its financial records as well as the MPO are not kept by the Clerk of the Court.

Forward Pinellas is the new brand for the unified agency that was formed by the Pinellas County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) merging with the Pinellas Planning Council (PPC). The PPC's mission is to maintain and enhance a representative forum for countywide planning and provides for overall policy direction, plan consistency, interagency coordination and technical assistance in furtherance of a coherent, efficient, and effective countywide planning process. In October, 2014, the staff to the MPO joined the PPC. The MPO was established in 1977 following the passage of the Federal Highway Act of 1974. The County's MPO facilitates collaboration of governments (state, regional, and municipal), interested parties, and residents in the transportation planning process.
