Rodney Chatman updated the members regarding Beach Community Access, the Vision for US 19 and the Gateway area. He noted that Forward Pinellas will be hosting a technical forum on waterborne transportation on October 7, 2016. The Notice to Proceed (NTP) has been issued for the S.R. 60 multimodal implementation strategy plan. The West Bay Drive Complete Streets alternatives evaluation scope of services is being developed and Forward Pinellas staff met with Largo on Friday to coordinate this effort with their West Bay Drive Trailhead project. Forward Pinellas staff is coordinating with Pinellas County on an economic assessment of the US 19 corridor in Palm Harbor. A joint study with FDOT on transit accessibility is nearing completion and is scheduled for committee review in September and Board action in October. A scope of services is currently being developed for a master plan for the Gateway area.
