Parker and Tessie Parker on November 8, 1961, and recorded in Official Records Book 1384, Page 68; a sewer easement granted by Leroy G. Parker and Tessie Parker on November 8, 1961, and recorded in Official Records Book 1384, Page 69, the nature and description of which are further described in the attached Exhibit "B", and

WHEREAS, possible unrecorded sewer easements in favor of South Cross Bayou Sanitary District over or across the rear five feet of lots 15 to 18 and 26 to 30 to connect with sewer easements recorded in Official Records Book 1384, Pages 61, 63, 65, 68 and 69 may exist on the subject property.

WHEREAS, South Cross Bayou Sanitary District was dissolved and consolidated into the Pinellas County Sewer System pursuant to 69-1479, Special Laws of Florida, and Resolution 69-363 of the Board of County Commissioners, dated September 9, 1969.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County, Florida that the above described property and plat be, and the same are hereby vacated, pursuant to 177.101, Florida Statutes, and that the


