HIGHLIGHTS

BUILDING & GROUNDS:

- Received \$1M state budget appropriation for 2500 Sq. ft. expansion & renovation of existing building; partnering with county to complete the project in 2017
- Creation of two modular study rooms for patron use, proctored exams, and special services (e.g. Medicare help)
- \$350K BP Settlement funds for shared parking lot with Cypress Woods Elementary School (project part of Master Plan)
- \$20K in MSTU funds to repair, reseal existing parking lot
- Facilitated removal of county recycling site on library property and replaced it with eight additional parking spaces
- New LED Road Sign to publicize library and community events
- Two new safety upgrades extension of entry lane into the ELCL driveway; installation of a guardrail along the East Lake Road sidewalk.
- Leased a modular building to alleviate overcrowded workspaces and prepare for the construction phase of the building expansion.

PROGRAMMING & SERVICES:

- The # of teen programs increased by 300% and the attendance figures for teens increased by 1400%!
- Created an in-house READ Box contains a collection of bestsellers (and DVDs starting in December) that are immediately available for checkout.
- Several new popular programs, including Gently Yoga for adults and Ready, Set, Learn for preschoolers.
