SUBJECT: Pinellas County Construction Licensing Board Amendment

DATE: February 3, 2017

Based on the discussion at the February 2, 2017 joint meeting of the Pinellas County Legislative Delegation and Board of County Commissioners (BCC) regarding the Pinellas County Construction Licensing Board (PCCLB) local bill adopted by the delegation, staff has drafted a revised amendment. The local bill as passed by the delegation updated the names of the appointing organizations and added a contractor to represent the remodeling industry.

The following are proposed changes to the local bill:

- Adding a designee of the County Administrator to the PCCLB.
- Restoring the requirement that the nominating organizations submit a list of names.
- Establishing the BCC as the appointing body.
- Reinstating term limits for the members of the PCCLB, as existed in the original special act.

These changes will ensure a smooth appointment process, provide increased accountability for the PCCLB and ensure responsiveness to the BCC, the Public and the contracting community.

Staff will place this item on your Board agenda for next Tuesday.

(1) The Pinellas County Construction Licensing Board is created, within the county of Pinellas, consisting of twenty-three(23) twenty-one (21) members, two (2) of whom are primarily engaged in business as general contractors; two (2) of whom are primarily engaged in business as building contractors, two (2) of whom are primarily engaged in business as residential contractors, one (1) who is a remodeling contractor, one (1) who

Members of the board shall be selected as follows: The three (3) building directors of the City of Clearwater, City of St. Petersburg and the County of Pinellas; one (1) North county building director and one (1) South County building director submitted by the Florida Suncoast Chapter of the International Code Counsil and Building Officials Association of Florida and appointed selected by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners from the municipalities listed in subsection (1); one (1) Beach Community building director appointed from a list of three (3) nominees submitted by The Barrier Island Government Council; one (1) County Administrator's designee; a Florida Registered Architect appointed from a list of three recommended architects submitted by the AIA Tampa Bay chapter of the American Institute of Architects Florida Central Chapter, St. Petersburg and Clearwater Sections; two (2) of whom are primarily engaged in the business as general contractors from a list of five (5) submitted by ABC, Associated Builders and Contractors, Inc. business as residential building contractors from a list of five (5) submitted by the Tampa Bay Builders Association Contractors and Builders Association of Pinellas County; one (1) who is a licensed and registered contractor who is primarily engaged in the Remodeling Industry submitted by the National Association of the Remodeling Industry, Tampa Bay (NARI); one (1) who is an electrical contractor submitted from a list of five (5) supplied by the Electrical Council of Florida (ECF), Pinellas County Chapter; one (1) who is a Plumbing contractor submitted from a list of five (5) supplied by the Pinellas Association of Plumbing, Heating & Cooling Contractors, Inc.; two (2) of whom are fire marshals, who shall be active members of the Pinellas County Fire Chiefs' Tampa Bay Area Fire Marshals Association, submitted from a list of five (5) supplied nominated by said association, one of whom shall serve an initial term of three (3) years, with successors to serve for a term of two (2) years thereafter; one (1) who is a mechanical contractor or Class A air conditioning contractor submitted from a list of (5) supplied by the Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Contractors' Association ("RACCA"); one (1) roofing or sheet metal contractor from a list of five (5) supplied submitted by the West Coast Roofing Contractors Association, and one (1) swimming pool, aluminum or veneer specialty contractor from a list of five (5) supplied submitted by the United Pool and Spa Association or Alliance of Florida Contractors appointed selected by the

Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners; one consumer member to be appointed by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners in accordance with paragraph 2(a). Should any of the associations or organizations referenced herein change their names then this law will recognize the successor association or organization. The building director members from the City of Clearwater, from the City of St. Petersburg and Pinellas County, shall be permanent members of the board. All other members shall serve two (2) years terms. All members, except those who are members by virtue of their employment by a governmental entity, shall serve no more than two (2) consecutive terms; there shall be no limit on the number of terms served by a governmental employee serving as a function of their employment. The following members shall commence their terms in even-numbered years: the Florida registered architect, one (1) general contractor, one (1) building contractor or, one (1) residential building contractor, one (1) electrical contractor, one (1) fire marshal, the North county, South county, and Beach Community building directors. The following members shall commence their terms in odd-numbered years: one (1) general contractor, one (1) building contractor, one (1) residential building contractor, one (1) remodeling contractor, one (1) County Administrator's designee one (1) mechanical contractor, one (1) plumbing contractor, one (1) fire marshal, one (1) roofing or sheet metal contractor, one (1) swimming pool, aluminum or veneer specialty

contractor, and one (1) consumer member. As the terms of members expire, the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County shall appoint a member to fill the vacancy for a term of two (2) years in the same manner as that membership was originally filed. The architect, contractor, electrical, plumbing and mechanical members shall be selected from the county at large. The board shall elect one of its members to serve as chairman and one of its members to serve as vice-chairman, for a term to be set by the board of no longer than two (2) years. A chairman shall serve no more than four (4) consecutive years. All terms of office expire on September 30 of the last year of the term. Vacancies in the membership occurring prior to the end of a member's term for any cause shall be filled by appointment in the same manner as that membership was originally filled.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
