## Highlights

- Increasing levels of recommendation by citizens of Pinellas County as a place to live, work, raise children and retire, coupled with minimal plans to move away over the next year paint a picture of a stable base of residents.
- Quality of life perspectives indicate significantly more residents both content at present and optimistic towards the future, than discontent.
- Traffic congestion, quality of education and jobs are top of mind concerns impacting overall quality of life of those who shared a negative outlook.
- Expectations in 2017 exceeded 2016 across nearly every category, and experience ratings exceeded 2016 in every category.
- Strongest alignment: presence of parks and public spaces, sense of community and availability of jobs for my skillset
- Weakest alignment: traffic flow on major roads, safe pedestrian travel, support services for the homeless
- Gaps closed for all measured categories in 2017, with the exception of presence of parks and public spaces
- While overall, expectation gaps continue to close, geographically, residents pose varied perceptions of community characteristics, reflecting unique assets and challenges within each region.
- Levels of Pinellas County government trust and confidence rising year-over and exceeding national levels suggests a strongly favorable citizen perspective of elected officials leading the charge.


## County Recommendation

- Approximately 9 in 10 resident respondents indicated that they would recommend Pinellas County as a place to live, work, raise children and retire.

## Recommendation Trends

- Likelihood of recommending Pinellas County as a place to live, work, raise children and retire has significantly increased since the initial measure in 2012.
- Respondents reported year-over increases across all five categories in the most recent survey, though recommendation of Pinellas County as a place to work was the only significant increase ( $88.7 \%$ to $91.8 \%$ ).

## Quality of Life in Pinellas

- A majority (71\%) of residents perceive quality of life to be better or just as good compared to five years ago.
- Future optimism also prevailed, with $85 \%$ projecting the next five years to be better or just as good as the present.

## 2016 Change

- Expectations in 2017 exceeded 2016 across nearly every category
- 2017 experience ratings exceeded 2016 across every category
- Gaps closed for all measured categories in 2017, with the exception of presence of parks and public spaces

## Trust \& Confidence

- 9 in 10 (93\%) residents reported having a great deal to a fair amount of trust and confidence in Pinellas County government's handling of County issues.
- Pinellas County trust and confidence ratings increased between 2016 and 2017 (91\% to 93\%).
