


Total Estimated Revenue

Interlocal Agreement (draft)

- Nearly Identical to Current/Previous Interlocals
- Distribution Population-Based Formula based on State Statute (2016 population estimates)
- Countywide Investments
 - Percentage Basis vs Fixed Amount
 - 11.3% (estimated \$225M)
 - Courts & Jail Facilities (3.0%, est. \$60M)
 - Economic Development Capital Projects & Housing (8.3%, est. \$165M)
- Target Date for BCC Execution July 18
