Paradise Valley, Ariz., mobile home community owner and operator Patrick O'Malley purchased the 15.37-acre Tarponaire Mobile Home Park for \$6.3 million.


The price equated to \$409,889 per acre.

Dan Mulkey of Marcus & Millichap's Tampa office handled the transaction.

The park is age restricted and located on Lake Tarpon and U.S. 19. It has more than 135 home sites, some of which are vacant. The community consists of both single- and doublewide homes, and has a clubhouse, shuffleboard courts and boat docks.

Mulkey says the lake frontage offered the buyer the opportunity to upgrade many of the homes on site.

- No. Dog waste is raw sewage. Stormwater ponds and swales are not designed to treat the pathogens in raw sewage. Stormwater is not treated at a sewage treatment plant. The stormwater from ponds is released into pipes and ditches that discharge directly to streams and bays.

- Q: How can pet waste harm humans?
- A: Pet waste contains many harmful pathogens which can cause mild distress to serious diseases.

Organism	Common Name	Survival / Human Disease
Toxocaracanis	Roundworms	Survival: • 4 years in soil. Human Disease: VLM (visceral larva migrans) or toxocariasis, an infection caused by certain parasites, leading to enlargement of the liver (hepatomegaly) inflammation of the middle muscular layer of the heart wall (myocarditis) inflammation of the kidneys (nephritis), inflammation of the lungs (pneumonitis) and blindness. Usually in children, but can occur in adults.
Baylisascaris procyonis (g. Toxocara)	Roundworms	Survival: • Eggs can survive in moist soil for years. Human Disease: Severe neurological form of VLM (visceral larva migrans, seabove), especially in young children.
Ancylostoma spp.	Hookworms	Survival: Several days. No known effective chemical or pesticide. Prompt removal of dog and cat feces greatly reduces risk of infection. Human Disease: Spreading lesions and severe itching (pruritis). In rare instances can cause symptoms like VLM (see above). Puppies are a significant source of infection.
Cryptosporidium parvum	none	Survival: At least 6 months. Susceptible to drying. Human Disease: Self-limiting inflammation of the lining membrane of the stomach and the intestines (gastroenteritis), protracted in susceptible individuals CDC reports 300,000 cases annually, 90% of waterborne origin.
Campylobacter	none	Survival: • Rapidly killed by heat, drying, and freezing.
spp. Escherichia coli	E. coli, Fecal coliform bacteria	Human Disease: Mild to severe, bloody diarrhea. Survival: Up to 4 months in ruminant (cattle) feces. Extended exposure (i.e., 3 days) at 140°F required to kill organism. Human Disease: Bloody diarrhea, severe cramps, blood clots in the kidne (hemolytic uremic syndrome or HUS), leading to kidney failure.
Giardia duodenalis lamblia (Giardia intestinalis)	<i>Giardia</i> , Giardiasis	Survival: Resistant to drying, chlorination, and temperature extremes. Can survive for months in water. Relatively persistent during wastewater treatment. Human Disease: Diarrhea, cramps, gas (flatulence), nausea, an excess of fat is stools (steatorrhea). Can be protracted and debilitating. CDC estimates 2 million cases in U.S., 90% of waterborne origin.
Salmonella spp.	none	Survival: Up to 6 months in cattle feces. Extended exposure at 140°F required to kill organism. Human Disease: Usually, mild inflammation of the lining membrane of the stomach and the intestines (gastroenteritis) within 6-48 hours.
Brucella spp.	Brucellosis	Survival: • 2½ months in moist soil • Rapidly killed by direct sunlight exposure. Human Disease: Weakness, extreme exhaustion on slight effort, night sweat chills, remittent fever, and generalized aches and pains appear in days to months. Can be protracted and extremely debilitating. Uncommon in U.S.
Yersinia enterocolitica	none	Survival: • Unknown. Human Disease: Mild inflammation of the lining membrane of the stomach and the intestines (gastroenteritis).
Leptospira interrogans	Leptospirosis	Survival: • Weeks to months in soil or water. Human Disease: Usually mild fever but complications can be serious, includin inflammation of the liver (hepatitis), interference with normal production and discharge of bile (jaundice), inflammation of the membranes that envelop the bra and spinal cord (meningitis), and kidney failure. Life threatening, but uncommon there has been a recent increase in the numbers of dogs with leptospires.
