We understand that this is a multi-year plan and we appreciate the county staff and their assistance in working on these projects and the funding required to complete the objectives. - Provided BP Funding to East Lake for Marine 57 (Air Boat) (\$150K) completed end of 2017.
- Participating Member in the Tampa Bay Search & Rescue Council hosted by US Coast Guard.
