The 2 (two) Case Managers will work with Foster Children who have been assigned to an Assistant Public Defender (APD) in the Juvenile Crossover Court.

There are currently 2652 Foster Children in Pinellas/Pasco County. The Eckerd Community Alternative Program (ECAP) is the only agency that is assigned to assist these children. The turnover rate for Case Managers with ECAP is 73%¹. Case Managers are often the only adult support these children have in their lives. This is the primary factor leading these children to become involved in the Crossover Court System.
