22	shall be employees of and compensated by the board of
23	county commissioners; providing an effective date.

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26 27 Subsections (1), (2), and (3) of section 12 of Section 1. 28 chapter 75-489, Laws of Florida, as amended by chapters 89-504, 93-387, and 2003-319, Laws of Florida, are amended, and 29 30 subsections (4) and (5) are added to that section to read: 31 Section 12. PINELLAS COUNTY CONSTRUCTION LICENSING BOARD: 32 ORGANIZATION: MEETINGS AND POWERS.-33 (1)(a) The Pinellas County Construction Licensing Board is created within the county of Pinellas, consisting of the 34 35 following nine (9) twenty-one (21) members: τ 36 1. Four (4) members licensed in any of the following 37 professions, with a maximum of one (1) member from any one of sub-subparagraphs a.-j., each of whom must be: 38 39 a. two (2) of whom are Primarily engaged in business as a 40 general contractor contractors; b. two (2) of whom are Primarily engaged in business as a 41 42 building contractor; contractors, 43 two (2) of whom are Primarily engaged in business as a с. 44 residential contractor; contractors, 45 d. A Florida-registered one (1) who is A Florida 46 registered architect doing business in Pinellas County;7 e. one (1) who is An electrical contractor; -47 one (1) who is A plumbing contractor; -48 f. one (1) who is A mechanical contractor or a Class A air 49 g. 50 conditioning contractor; -

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51 one who is A roofing or sheet metal contractor; τ h. 52 one (1) who is A swimming pool, aluminum, or veneer i. 53 specialty contractor; or, 54 A two (2) fire marshal. marshals, j. 55 2. The three (3) building officials directors of the 56 following: City of St. Petersburg, the City of Clearwater, and 57 the County of Pinellas., One (1) North county building director 58 from one of the following municipalities: Tarpon Springs, Dunedin, Oldsmar, Safety Harbor, Belleair, Belleair Bluffs, or 59 60 Largo, One (1) South county building director from one of the following municipalities: South Pasadena, Gulfport, Seminole, 61 62 Kenneth City, or Pinellas Park, one (1) Beach Community building director from one of the following: the Town of Belleair Beach, 63 the Town of Belleair Shores, the City of Redington Beach, the 64 City of North Redington Beach, the City of Madeira Beach, the 65 66 City of Indian Rocks Beach, the Town of Indian Shores, the Town 67 of Redington Shores, the City of Treasure Island, and the City 68 of St. Pete Beach,

69 <u>3. Two (2)</u> and One (1) consumer <u>members</u> member who <u>are</u> 70 <u>residents</u> is a resident and citizen of Pinellas County and who 71 <u>are</u> is not and never <u>have</u> has been <u>members or practitioners</u> a 72 member or practitioner of any of the trades or professions 73 regulated by the board <u>or members or practitioners</u> a member or 74 practitioner of any closely related trade or profession.

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(b) All members of the board <u>must</u> shall be residents of

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76 Pinellas County and appointed by the Chairman of the Board of 77 County Commissioners.

78 (2)(a) To be eligible for membership in appointment to the 79 first board appointed after the effective date of this act, each 80 member, other than the building officials buildings director, 81 the architect, and the consumer members, must member, shall 82 personally hold an unexpired certified license issued by the 83 City of St. Petersburg, or the City of Clearwater, or the County of Pinellas, or the State of Florida at the time of appointment; 84 85 be actively engaged in their respective businesses and have been so engaged for a period of at least 5 five consecutive years 86 87 before the date of appointment; and be a citizen and resident of 88 the county.

(b) Each member of the board, other than the building officials directors, the architect and the consumer members member, succeeding the original appointees must shall possess the qualifications prescribed in paragraph (2)(a).

93 94 (3) Members of the board shall be selected as follows:

95 The three (3) building directors of the City of Clearwater, 96 City of St. Petersburg and the County of Pinellas; one (1) North 97 county building director and one (1) South county building 98 director selected by the Chairman of the Board of County 99 Commissioners from the municipalities listed in subsection (1); 100 one (1) Beach Community building director appointed from a list

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101 of three (3) nominees submitted by The Barrier Island Governmental Council; a Florida registered architect appointed 102 103 from a list of three recommended architects submitted by the 104 American Institute of Architects Florida Central Chapter, St. 105 Petersburg and Clearwater Sections; two (2) of whom are 106 primarily engaged in business as general contractors from a list 107 of five (5) submitted by the Associated General Contractors of 108 Mid Florida, Inc.; two (2) of whom are primarily engaged in 109 business as Building Contractors from a list of five (5) 110 submitted by the Contractors and Builders Association of Pinellas County; two (2) of whom are primarily engaged in the 111 112 business as residential building contractors from a list of five 113 (5) submitted by the Contractors and Builders Association of 114 Pinellas County; one (1) who is An electrical contractor from a 115 list of five (5) supplied by the Electrical Council of Florida, 116 Pinellas County Chapter; one (1) who is a Plumbing contractor from a list of five (5) supplied by the Pinellas Association of 117 118 Plumbing Heating Cooling Contractors, Inc.; two (2) of whom are 119 fire marshals, who shall be active members of the Tampa Bay Area 120 Fire Marshals Association, from a list of five (5) supplied by 121 said association, one (1) of whom shall serve an initial term of 122 three (3) years, the other to serve an initial term of two (2) years, with successors to serve for a term of two (2) years 123 124 thereafter; one (1) who is a mechanical or Class A air 125 conditioning contractor from a list of five (5), supplied by the

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126 Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Contractors' Association 127 ("RACCA"); one (1) roofing or sheet metal contractor and one (1) 128 swimming pool, aluminum, or veneer specialty contractor selected 129 by the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners; one consumer member to be appointed by the Chairman of the Board of 130 131 County Commissioners in accordance with paragraph 2(a). The 132 building official director members from the City of Clearwater, 133 from the City of St. Petersburg, and Pinellas County, shall be 134 permanent members of the board. Half of the remaining members 135 initially appointed after the effective date of this act shall 136 serve terms of 2 years and the other half shall serve terms of 4 137 years, with such appointments made at the discretion of the 138 Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County. All other 139 members shall serve terms of two (2) years. The following 140 members shall commence their terms in even-numbered years: the 141 Florida registered architect, one (1) general contractor, one 142 (1) building contractor or, one (1) residential building 143 contractor, one (1) electrical contractor, one (1) fire marshal, 144 the North county, South county, and Beach Community building directors. The following members shall commence their terms in 145 146 odd numbered years: one (1) general contractor, one (1) building 147 contractor, one (1) residential building contractor, one (1) 148 mechanical contractor, one (1) plumbing contractor, one (1) fire 149 marshal, one (1) roofing or sheet metal contractor, one (1) 150 swimming pool, aluminum or veneer specialty contractor, and one

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151 (1) consumer member. As the terms of initial members appointed 152 after the effective date of this act expire, the Chairman of the 153 Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County shall appoint 154 all members a member to terms fill the vacancy for a term of 4 155 $\frac{1}{1}$ two (2) years in the same manner as the original appointment. 156 Individuals seeking appointment to the board shall complete an application form that solicits information as to the applicant's 157 relevant experience, areas of expertise, and potential conflicts 158 159 of interest. The application shall be reviewed by the county 160 attorney and the Board of County Commissioners of Pinellas County prior to consideration for appointment that membership 161 162 was originally filled. An appointed member may not serve more than two consecutive terms; however, such persons may be 163 164 reappointed if they have not been in office for 3 consecutive 165 years The architect, contractor, electrical, plumbing and 166 mechanical members shall be selected from the county at large. 167 The board shall elect from its members a chair and vice chair for a term of no longer than 2 years each one of its members to 168 169 serve as chairman and one of its members to serve as vice-170 chairman, for a term to be set by the board. A chair shall serve 171 no more than 4 consecutive years. All terms of office expire on 172 September 30 of the last year of the term. Vacancies in the membership occurring prior to the end of a member's term for any 173 174 cause shall be filled by appointment in the same manner as the 175 original appointment that membership was originally filled.

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176 (4) The board may regulate local licensure and handle the 177 discipline of local contractors and is authorized to employ 178 personnel and incur expense as necessary to perform its duties and enforce this section. Staff shall be employees of the board 179 180 of county commissioners, and the board is responsible for all costs associated therewith. The board is a dependent agency of 181 182 the board of county commissioners. The board of county 183 commissioners may adopt additional rules and regulations not 184 contained within this act. Pinellas County has the countywide 185 authority to safeguard the life, health, property, and public 186 welfare of Pinellas County residents through the regulation, 187 oversight, and enforcement of construction and home improvement 188 within Pinellas County. The county attorney or his or her designee shall 189 (5) 190 attend all board meetings to advise the board in developing, 191 implementing, and adhering to written policies and procedures 192 and internal controls to ensure that the board is fully complying with all of its statutory duties, including, but not 193 194 limited to, its responsibility to monitor construction activity 195 in Pinellas County and respond to administrative complaints from 196 citizens against licensed contractors. 197 Section 14 of chapter 75-489, Laws of Florida, Section 2. 198 as amended by chapter 89-504, Laws of Florida, is amended to 199 read:

203	(1) Except as herein provided, the board shall have
204	concurrent jurisdiction with municipal examining boards.
205	(2) The board shall have the duty to promulgate rules and

207	those engaging in countywide contracting and shall provide for
208	the examination of those so engaged.
209	(3) The board shall have the duty to promulgate rules and

218	(6) Each board member has the duty to file an annual
219	statement of financial interests pursuant to s. 112.3145,
220	Florida Statutes.
221	(7) The board has the duty to provide an annual
222	independent financial audit to the Board of County Commissioners
223	of Pinellas County and each municipal government in Pinellas
224	County. The annual audit shall include a detailed summary of the
225	board's efforts to monitor construction activity in Pinellas
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226 County and its response and processing of administrative 227 complaints from citizens against licensed contractors. 228 The board is subject to an audit by the Division of (8) Inspector General contained within the Office of the Clerk of 229 230 Circuit Court of Pinellas County at the request of the Pinellas 231 County Board of County Commissioners. 232 Section 3. Section 21 of chapter 75-489, Laws of Florida, 233 as amended by chapter 89-504, Laws of Florida, is amended to 234 read: 235 Section 21. FEES.-236 (1) The board is authorized to establish reasonable fees 237 for certification, registration, examination, Board of 238 Adjustment and Appeals hearings, annual renewal fees, and such 239 other fees deemed necessary to accomplish the purpose of this 240 act. 241 (2) Any funds received by the board from fees which remain 242 uncommitted and unexpended at the end of each biennium shall be 243 paid into the county general revenue fund. 244 Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

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
