This Grant supplements County funding of PCFL's operating costs, reducing reliance on local general revenue funding support. Execution of the Criminal Laboratory Financial Assistance Agreement serves as acceptance of Grant funding. Criminal fines collected statewide, under Sections 938.07 and 938.55 Florida Statutes, fund the Grant. FDLE disperses funding quarterly based upon the total fines collected in that quarter and a pre-determined distribution percentage. Pinellas County will receive 12.67% of the relevant criminal fines collected in FY18.
