Background

- Required by the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act
- National Outer Continental Shelf Program is a schedule of proposed oil and gas lease sales in the Outer Continental Shelf that the Secretary of Interior authorizes for a 5 year period.
- Outer Continental Shelf is divided into 4 regions, containing 26 planning areas.

2019-2024 Draft Proposed Program (DPP)

- Includes 47 potential leases in 25 of 26 planning areas.
- Includes 12 leases in the Gulf of Mexico, 2 in the Eastern Gulf of Mexico.
- Currently the Eastern Gulf of Mexico is under a moratorium through June 30, 2022.
- 2019-2024 National OCS Program will replace existing 2017-2022 Program.



Timeline

- April 2017-President Trump issued Executive Order, implementing the America-First Offshore Energy Strategy
- July 3, 2017- August 17, 2017- Request for Information (RFI) 45 day comment period
- January 5, 2018 Draft Proposed Program (DPP) released by BOEM
 - January 8- March 9, 2018- 60 day comment period
- Proposed Program (PP) released by BOEM
 - 90 day comment period
- Proposed Final Program (PFP) released by BOEM
 - 60 day period for President and Congress to review
- Program Approved and Signed by Secretary

- February 8, 2018 Public hearing on DPP in Tallahassee
- February 22, 2018 Public hearing on DPP in Washington D.C.
- Submit comments on DPP
- Resolution regarding National OCS Plan?
 - Similar resolutions signed by BCC in 2006, 2009
