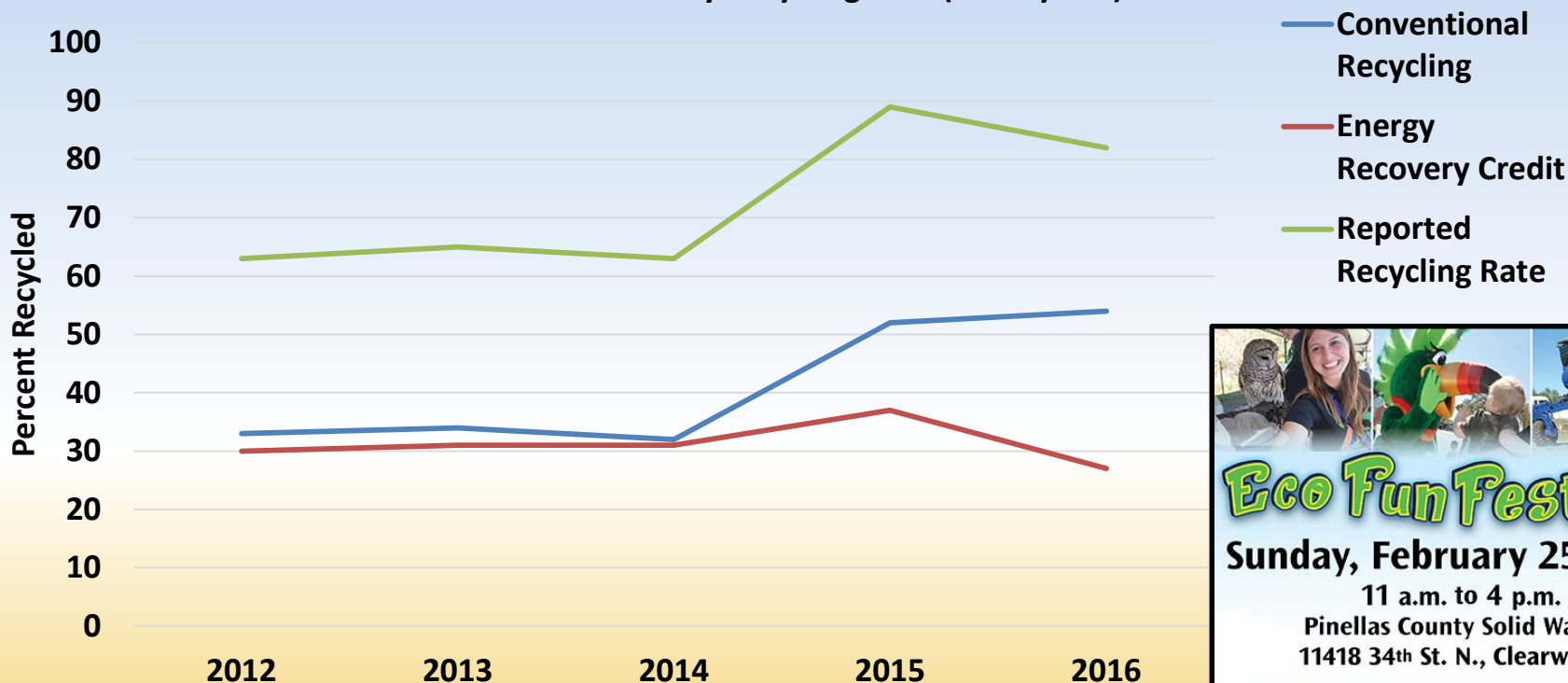

- Average of 400 customers per day will benefit from a reduced reweigh time of up to 50%



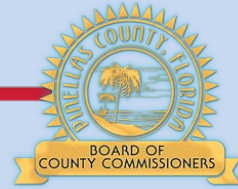
Things Done

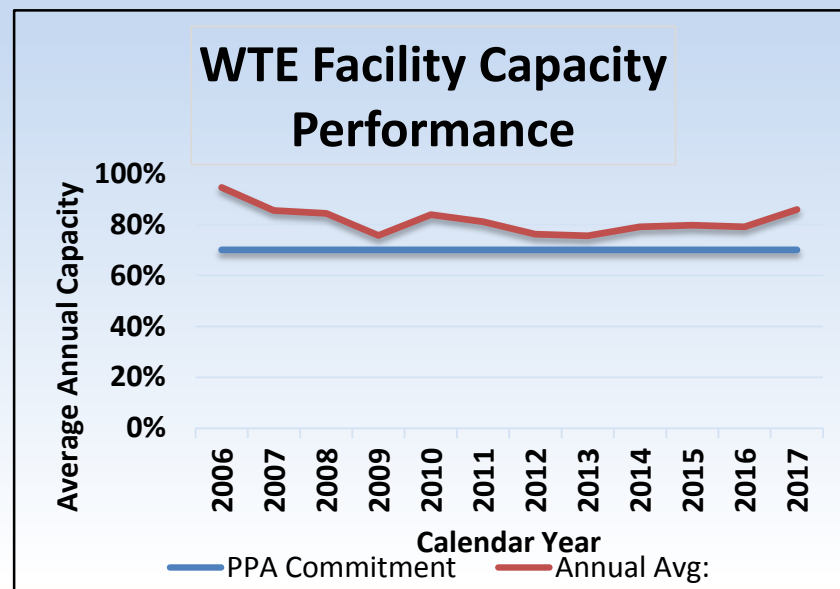
- Lealman Franchise collection
