SUMMARY

This proposed amendment is submitted by the City of Clearwater and seeks to amend a property totaling approximately 7.5 acres from Recreation/Open Space (intended to recognize areas appropriate for public and private open spaces and recreational facilities that serve the community or region) to Public/Semi-Public (intended to recognize institutional and transportation/utility uses that serve the community or region, especially larger facilities having acreage exceeding the thresholds established in other plan categories, and which are consistent with the need, character, and scale of such uses relative to the surrounding uses, transportation facilities, and natural resource features.

The subject property is primarily vacant and has a solid waste transfer station in the center of the remainder of the site. The proposed use is a new solid waste transfer station. If approved, this amendment will be consistent with the City of Clearwater's Comprehensive Plan.

FINDINGS

Staff submits the following findings in support of the recommendation for approval:

- A. The Public/Semi-Public category recognizes the proposed use of the site, and is consistent with the criteria for utilization of this category.
- B. The proposed amendment either does not involve, or will not significantly impact, the remaining relevant countywide considerations.
