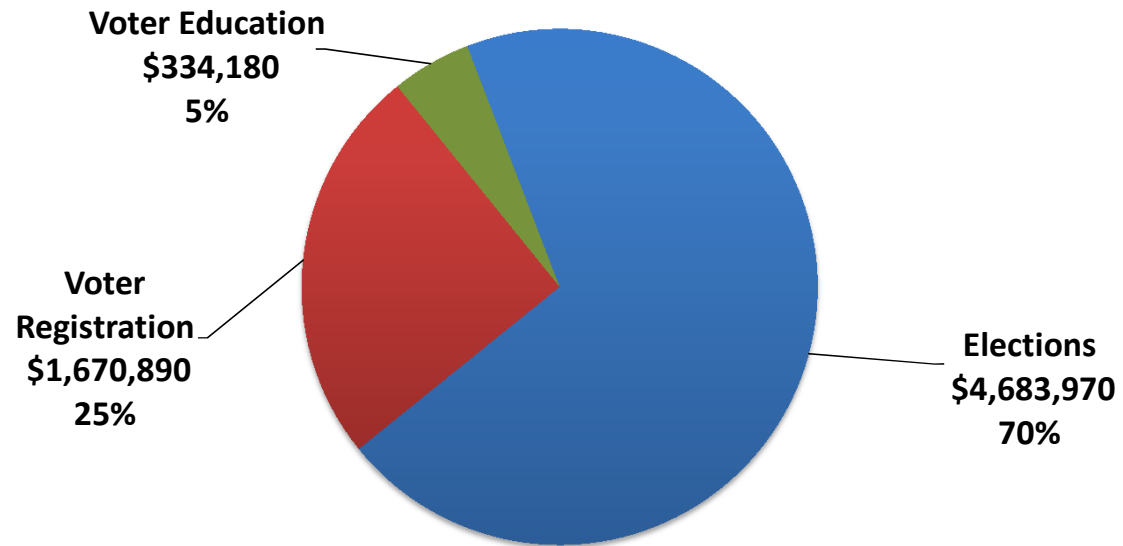


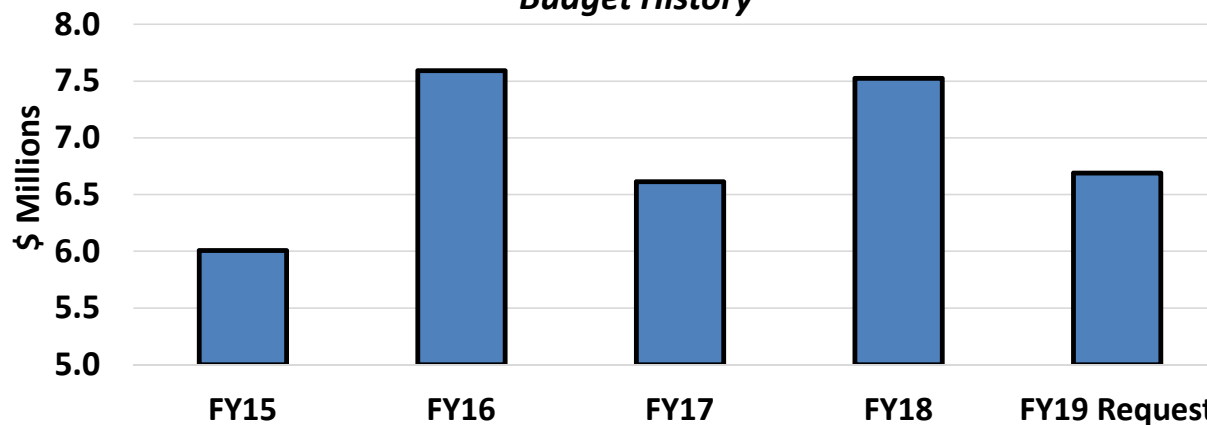
# SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS

*Budget History*



The Supervisor of Elections budget fluctuates from year to year due to the elections administered in each fiscal year. The Supervisor of Elections' budget submission of \$6,689,040 met their FY19 budget target. This submission does not include a non-recurring request of \$1.1M to replace the Pitney Bowes "Relia-Vote" ballot mailing system, including upgrades to servers and workstations, new sorter and inserter systems, as well as replacement of components that have reached end of life and are no longer manufactured or supported.

# SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS

The Supervisor of Elections conducts all Federal, State, County, and Municipal elections. The Supervisor registers voters and maintains accurate voter registration records in accordance with the National Voter Registration Act (NVRA), Florida law, and the Florida Voter Registration System (FVRS). The Supervisor recruits, trains, and assigns poll workers, locates and contracts with polling places, surveys polling places, and makes improvements to comply with ADA accessibility requirements. The Supervisor conducts voter registration and education for college, high school, middle, and elementary school students. The Supervisor has the sample ballots published in newspapers and mailed to voters. The Supervisor complies with bilingual requirements of Section 203 of the Voting Rights Act.
