Lealman Community Campus

Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT (hereinafter "Agreement") is entered into on this the <u>29</u> day of June, 2018, by and between Pinellas County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, with an address of 315 Court Street, Clearwater, Florida 33756 (hereinafter "County"), and the Lealman Community District Services, Inc., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Florida, with an address of 3755 46th Avenue North, St. Petersburg, Florida 33714 (hereinafter "LCDS"), jointly referred to as the "Parties."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 15-62 passed on June 23, 2015, the County determined that conditions of slum and/or blight, as defined by Chapter 163, Part III, Florida Statutes exist in the Lealman community, and approved the creation of the Lealman Community Redevelopment Area (Lealman CRA); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 16-40, and as amended by Resolution 17-36, the County adopted the Lealman Community Redevelopment Area Plan (the "Plan") to eliminate such conditions of slum and/or blight; and

WHEREAS, the Plan identifies a need for additional community services in the Lealman CRA; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with and in furtherance of the Plan, the County began negotiations to purchase the property located at 5175 45th Street North, St. Petersburg, Pinellas County Florida, 33714-2266 (the "Property") to establish a community center within the Lealman CRA to provide such community services; and

WHEREAS, the State allocated two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) to LCDS from the State General Revenue Fund to the Department of Economic Opportunity to fund a community center in Lealman as described in Project Appropriations Request # 0917; and

WHEREAS, the County entered into a contract to purchase the Property on October 31, 2017, as amended November 13, 2017, for a purchase price of eleven million dollars (\$11,000,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the County obtained the Property via Special Warranty Deed on January 29, 2018, as recorded in Pinellas County Official Records Book 19923, Pages 97-101, attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the County is currently utilizing the Property as a community center ("Lealman Community Campus") and is actively seeking tenants to provide additional community services within the Lealman CRA; and

WHEREAS, the State funding appropriated pursuant to Appropriations Project Request #0917 must be allocated by June 29, 2018; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to consolidate resources and facilitate the full operation of the Lealman Community Campus, the Parties have determined that the funds are best utilized toward the purchase price of the Lealman Community Campus, and the State has determined that said funds be utilized toward the purchase price is appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the County intends on completing the projects outlined in Exhibit B with projects numbered 1 through 3 completed projects, numbers 4 through 14 as projects to be implemented and completed by December 31st, 2018, and projects numbered 15 through 18 as projects to be implemented and completed by September 30th, 2019, and will provide LCDS with a quarterly status reports within 30 days of the end of each quarter in the County's fiscal year to include a financial report, projects status, cost overrun or savings; and

WHEREAS the County agrees to provide advance notice of any project delays, timeline extensions, and or variances of expenses that exceed 5% of the listed project estimates outlined in Exhibit B for LCDS Board approval.

WHEREAS, LCDS agrees to authorize County to be the agent to receive the State funding appropriated pursuant to Appropriations Project Request #0917.

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Recitals

The above recitals are true and accurate and are hereby incorporated by reference.

2. LCDS Commitment

LCDS hereby authorizes the County to be the agent to receive the State funding appropriated pursuant to Appropriations Project Request #0917.

3. County Commitment

County shall utilize the \$2,000,000.00 toward the purchase price of the Lealman Community Campus. Additionally, it is the County's intent to complete the projects as outlined in Exhibit B.

4. Funding

In the unlikely event that the State of Florida does not allocate the funding described herein to County, this Agreement shall be null and void and neither party shall be liable or have an obligation to perform hereunder.

5. Requirements Applicable to the Purchase of or Improvements to Real Property

In accordance with s. 287.05805, F.S., if funding provided under this Agreement is used for the purchase of or improvements to real property, County shall grant the State of Florida

Department of Economic Opportunity a security interest in the Property in the amount of the funding provided by this Agreement for the purchase of or improvements to the real property for five years from the date of purchase or the completion of the improvements or as further required by law.

6. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida. Venue shall be in Pinellas County, Florida.

7. Entire Agreement

This Agreement represents the entire written agreement between the Parties and supersedes all prior communications and proposals, whether oral or written, between the Parties with respect to this Agreement.
