This management plan (Plan) is the result of an agreement between the County and the State of Florida which has been in effect since Dec. 8th, 2000 and is required to be updated every ten years. The estimated expenditures related to the management of Shell Key Preserve (\$191K) is included in the FY18 budget. Proposed changes to the Plan will be in effect beginning in FY19 if approved. The estimated increase in expenditures is \$57K for additional staff, offset by an estimated \$7K in revenue for proposed camping permit fees, resulting in a net increase of approximately \$32K. If the Plan is approved and additional staff is needed, the department will include these expenditures in their FY19 budget request.
