

Notice of St. Petersburg City Council Public Hearing on Proposed Amendments to the Intown Redevelopment Plan (Rescheduled from July 19, 2018 to August 2, 2018)

Dear Mr. Woodard,

As required by the Florida Community Redevelopment Act of 1969 (Sec. 163.346, FS), the City of St. Petersburg is notifying taxing authorities whose jurisdictions include the **Intown Community Redevelopment Area** that the St. Petersburg City Council is expected to take action on the following ordinance.

Ordinance adopting Amendments to the Intown Redevelopment Plan (IRP) increasing the redevelopment program budget in Revised Table 2 from \$117.354 million to \$232.354 million to fund "Waterfront, Transit, and Parking Improvements" and "Rehabilitation and Conservation of Historic Resources" in the IRP east of 8<sup>th</sup> Street as well as "Redevelopment Infrastructure Improvements" in the IRP west of 8<sup>th</sup> Street; deleting from IRP Revised Table 2 projects that will not be funded by tax increment financing (TIF); and allowing reductions in TIF contributions to the IRP Redevelopment Trust Fund by the City of St. Petersburg and Pinellas County.

The public hearing related to this proposal will be held on August 2, 2018, beginning at 9:00 a.m. or thereafter in Council Chambers at City Hall, 175 Fifth Street North, St. Petersburg, Florida.
