Confirmed with Erin Lawson PM that FDOT is partially funding also but the roadwork is not on or intersecting and FDOT roads. Grant agreement requires FDOT to be named as additional insured and be provided a waiver of subrogation. Used similar recent project 178-0313 as a guide but removed references and requirements to CSX as there is no work within 50' of railway.

Both FDOT and City of Oldsmar need to be additional insured and have indemnification as well as waiver of subrogation
